Peace Committee Report 2009 - Germany

The Committee met 4 times in 2008/2009 – in September `08 with the Outreach Commitee; January ´09 with our Church and Peace Representative, Brian Tracy; in April ´09 with Freddy hut from the ZentralstelleKDV (Conscientious Objection) and with Quäker-Hilfe; and in July in the Community Jannishausen with Davorka Lovrekovic from the Versöhnungsbund (German Fellowship of Reconcilation).

Consideration of our Peace Testimony (which will be 350 years old next year) together with the Outreach Committee, led us to the insight that Peace Work can no longer be seen as separate from work for the Environment, or for Human Rights, as these issues have huge implications for Peace on a global scale. Our Testimonies for Simplicity and Equality are therefore very closely connected with our Peace Testimony.

Our close working with other groups and committees, both within and outside the Yearly Meeting are one outcome of this realisation.

Encouragement of concrete activities within the YM:

We encouraged local and regional Meetings in Germany to consider what the Peace Testimony means to us today, in preparation for potential outreach activities on the theme in 2010. Some Meetings have taken us up on our suggestions, and are organising events locally.

We actively supported Helga and Konrad Tempel in the compiling of the "Kompendiums zum Friedenszeugnis. " This small book is to be a record of peace work being undertaken in the Yearly Meeting at present.

Our Friend Julia Kramer travelled as a Peaceworker to Sudan in the Autumn, and took with her donations of English books on Non-Violence and other training material. As a result of the meeting with ZentralstelleKDV, 2 Friends have volunteered to provide advice to Young Friends about Conscientious Objection.
